Wapato Public Schools is asking voters within the Wapato School District boundaries to renew its Educational Programs & Operation (EP&O) Replacement Levy. The 4-year replacement levy proposal, which will appear on the February 10, 2026 ballot, is not a new tax. It would simply renew and replace the current 4-year levy which Wapato School District voters approved in February 2022. The current levy is set to expire in December of this year.

The District wants voters to be as informed as possible about the proposal prior to filling out their ballots so we encourage those who have questions to join us for one of the two upcoming levy information forums.
