

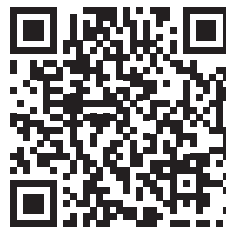
Free safety training workshop

The Focus Four Hazards
